

CARMEL CHOIR - JOB DESCRIPTION & CONTRACT

It is an honor and a privilege to be selected for this choir. This privilege comes with certain responsibilities to which you each must commit in order for this choir to achieve success.

1. I will commit to the entire year of choir. I will have an excellent attendance record, and I understand that if I am absent from dress rehearsals, I may be forfeiting my privilege to perform.
2. I will have a good to excellent voice which consistently functions well and I will take voice lessons if possible. Knowing that my body is my instrument, I will refrain from smoking, drinking, or using drugs in order to keep my "instrument" in good working condition.
3. I will work to improve my sight-reading skills by in-class using the various classroom resources, and any other outside means necessary to keep progressing.
4. I will maintain exceptional behavior in class facilitating class progress. I will treat adults and superiors with respect, and will always represent Carmel HS Choir with pride by conducting myself with dignity and maturity.
5. I will attend all choir performances and field-trips, and will attend school the following day, being attentive to making up all missed work.
6. I will pay all choir fees in a timely manner. I will try to participate in fundraisers. I will communicate with directors if I need financial assistance or an alternate payment plan.
7. I will manage my time schedule of school, church, family, social, and work commitments so that I have the energy and time to commit to this choir. This includes taking responsibility for letting the directors know well in advance of any schedule conflicts.
8. I will maintain a positive attitude in rehearsals even in the face of frustration and encourage my classmates to do the same.
9. I will keep my appearance clean cut, maintaining the proper "look" for choir performances:
For men: short hair, no longer than 3-4 inches and must be kept out of the eyes and off the neck. No facial hair of any kind allowed and sideburns must be no longer than 1 inch, no visible piercings.
For women: hair neatly pulled away from the face, with the ears showing, large, full curls. Matching makeup on all women, no visible piercings other than ears.
For everyone: Hair must be a natural color, no perfumes or cologne, required accessories
10. I will adhere to all expectations of the Carmel High School Performing Arts Department Code of Conduct including abstaining from the use of any illegal substance, or participating in any activity that is against the law. I understand that if I break this code of conduct, I will be jeopardizing my eligibility for participation in the Carmel Choir Program.
11. I understand that if the above responsibilities are not met, I may be forfeiting my right to participate in this ensemble.
